PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS – Centerville School received a Rural Community Improvement Grant from Northwest Farm Credit Service to improve our playground. Phase 1, the structure border, has already been completed. Come and see the border around the play structure that contains the rubber mulch fall-zone material. The 2nd phase will begin next week. We will be providing drainage ditches around the playground to divert water from the play area to the county bar ditch and connecting culvert. The 3rd and final phase will begin in the near future. All students and staff look forward to a playground area that is accessible for all students during all seasons and all weather conditions.
