SCREENINGS - Student vision screening has been conducted at school. Referral letters were mailed to the parents of students who failed the screening.



WATER SYSTEM UPDATE - On Tuesday, Oct 3, the State Department of Health was at school and inspected our water system. Two of our water faucets are continuing to show an elevated lead count and another exceeds the acceptable level for copper. These are the same three water sources that failed before school started. All other water sources in the building showed no signs of elevated lead or copper. We are working to develop an appropriate solution to this issue with the guidance of Department of Health and our contracted Water Systems Manager. To be extra cautious, we are going to continue to use bottled water coolers for drinking water consumption. The food service program will also continue to use bottled water for all food preparation needs. Staff is asking for your assistance with our water bottles in the classroom. There are times that the "crinkly" plastic, store water bottles have been a huge distraction. If your family has access to hard plastic, closable water bottles, we would appreciate your child use those instead of the more expensive and loud plastic bottles. Re-useable hard plastic bottles do many things for us and for the environment: allow for quieter workspaces for thinking and learning, saves the plastic that will go back into our landfills. Staff will remind students to take reusable bottles home on weekends for proper cleaning and sanitizing. Thank you for supporting our position on this issue.
