



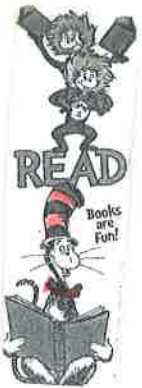
Centerville School NEWSLETTER
