LUNCH FEES – We ask all families to please complete and return your Free & Reduced lunch application form. This completed application allows the school to use the information to qualify for State and Federal programs. It also helps the family budget, as our school does not qualify for free lunches for all. If we reach a certain benchmark that the state has set, we will ALL receive free lunches. If you need the application form, it can be found on our website under Food Services or request a hard copy from Mrs. Musser to be sent home with your child. Meal prices: Student breakfast \$2.60, lunch \$3.20, milk \$.60. Funds can be placed into student accounts through the main office. Please note; it is against policy to allow charging of meals; please keep accounts current.

MICROWAVE - Due to regulations from the National Food Service Program, the microwave in the kitchen will no longer be available for student use.

CONNECTIONS - Connections between school and home, along with regular attendance, are two of



the most important components for student success. Please communicate often and regularly with your child's teacher. Email, phone calls, and written notes, are all appropriate ways to communicate between home and school. Teachers also require folders/binders to travel from school to home, and back to school daily.
